If this is ok I would keep it like it is otherwise we need to implement it a little bit more complicated with a check in the different sections whether the created string is already available (for versionable entities) or not (for cdmBase entities).

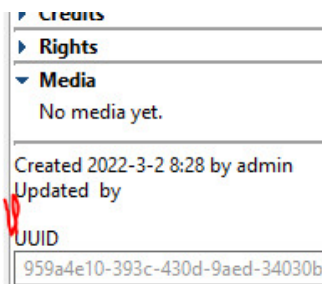
