Using the ctools exportable feature seems to be rather complicated.

Directly operating on the database in contrast is quire straight forward:

1. export (e.g.):

```
drush -l http://portal.cybertaxonomy.org/flora-cuba/ sql-dump --tables-list=flora_cuba_wysiwyg
```

1. copy the INSERT statement from the output

2. apply the insert on the target db:

3.a. in case of the installation profile :

{TABLE_PREFIX}wysiwyg

3.b. to update existing databases:

{TABLE_PREFIX}wysiwyg
