the selenium test only can work with one base theme which currently is Garland. So we have two options:			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. adapt the selenium test so that they can run on both themes, for which a ticket already exists: <a href="#">#4372</a></li><li>2. switch all integration portals to the zen_basetheme</li><li>3. make selenium tests independent from the themes. This would require that page elements like menu items etc can be identified by css selectors independently from the theme.</li></ol>			
<b>RISK:</b>			
Most portals are running with the zen_basetheme but the portals are not tested with this theme. It is generally not a big problem but is a potential risk.			
<b>COST:</b>			
Any of the solutions will need about two days to be fully implemented.
