<b>Description</b>			
Currently the order of type designations is unordered. We should implement a comparator to have a fixed order.			
Some suggestions for the comparator:			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Order by Status (TypeDesignationStatusBase is ordered), but maybe we need to update the order within the status voc. Anyway important is that holotype comes first.</li><li>2. Order by Specimen (for now, alphabetic order of titlecache should be ok)</li><li>3. Order by id (or uuid)</li><li>4. If no status is available it should come first. This way we put new records to top and set focus on empty records, same applies later for not defined specimen/names</li></ol>
