#### Description

The taxon tree should evaluate taxon uuids in the HTTP\_REFERER.

This will allow to the taxontree to be open at the taxon from which the user navigated to a media, specimen, or reference page.

The overall behaviour of the tree will be like:

1. Tree shows the current taxon of the taxon page in **bold**
2. If the current page is not a taxon page the tree will take the HTTP\_REFERER into account. If case it contains a taxon uuid, it expand at that taxon and display it in *normal* letters
3. Otherwise the tree is fully closed.
