Author1 sensu Author1 is shown where Author1 is the secundum reference (author) in both cases.</p> <p>Instead the misapplied name relationship reference/author should be shown.</p> <p>Example: Nepenthes gracillima</p> <p>http://caryophyllales.org/nepenthaceae/cdm_dataportal/taxon/53d8bdee-f688-4c98-a90a-ef794bc23845</p> <p>Also we need a better label for sensu here. Something like "misappl. sec./acc./sensu" (?). There is some email communication about the correct label. Need to find it.</p>
