Description If a feature tree in feature tree editor was changed and one clicks on "select new feature tree" a save dialog opens asking "You have to save ... Save now?". Answering with "NO" closes the dialog which is not the expected behavior. We need "Save, no save, cancel" as sometimes one does not want to save the changes. Also the dialog statement needs to be changed to "You have unsaved changes. Do you want to save?"
