a) Gomphonema juettnerii as registration by submitter + name status with ICN article citation by the curator			
b) Gomphonema juettnerae as registration by curator + Name relation a = orthographic variant of b			
unsolved problem: a) has all relevant type and specimen information, this should stay with the record a			
b) needs all information of record a			
Solution?: b should be a clone of a except of the corrected name string, and different name status. Possible?
