<b>Description</b>  When the taxeditor loads the default feature tree with an uuid but the table is empty or the uuid is the uuid of the defaultFeatureTree the tree is created on the fly. This works correctly and a feature tree with all terms of type "feature" is created. But the feature tree used in the editor contains only one FeatureNode, but every Node contains itself as child. And the rootNode contains this node as many times as the original feature tree contained features.  When going through the tree results in an endless loop.  When the default feature tree is created on taxeditor side, it works correctly.
