<b>Description</b>			
Just like in the taxon navigator it should be possible to move a term to another term which is selected in a dialog.  This is especially important for long, flat term vocabularies which have to be edited.  Maybe we also want Cut&Paste for the term editor.

- The focus is not directly set on the search button. So pressing "Enter" will press OK which does not do anything when nothing is selected
- it is not possible to select vocabularies with the term search

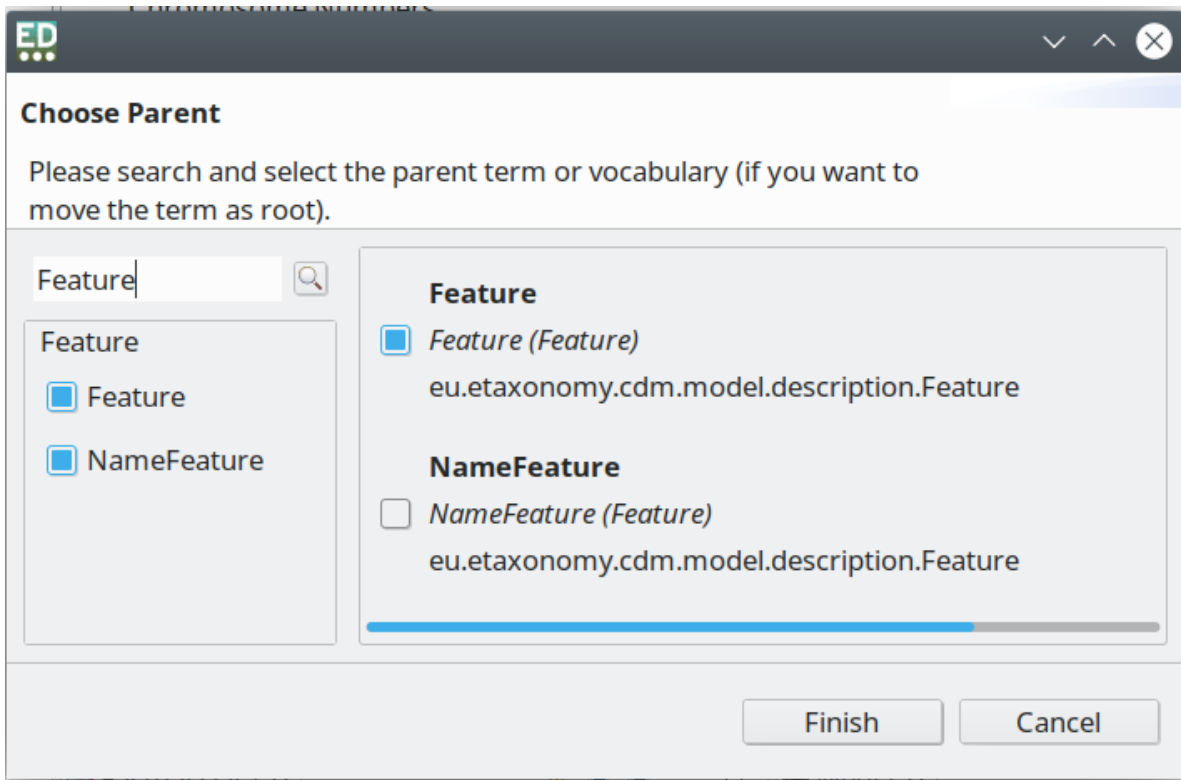

I discovered a dangerous behavior of the "Choose Parent" dialog:

When the focus is set to the filter text field one would expect that hitting ENTER would trigger the search to be executed. But instead the Enter-Key seems to be bound only to the "Finish" button so that the move operation can be triggered unintentionally.

(BTW, a button should be highlighted if it is the active button, that is when the pressing the ENTER key will trigger its action.)



I suggest to change the dialog behavior so that only the search is triggered when hitting enter. The action of the finish button should never be executed this way.

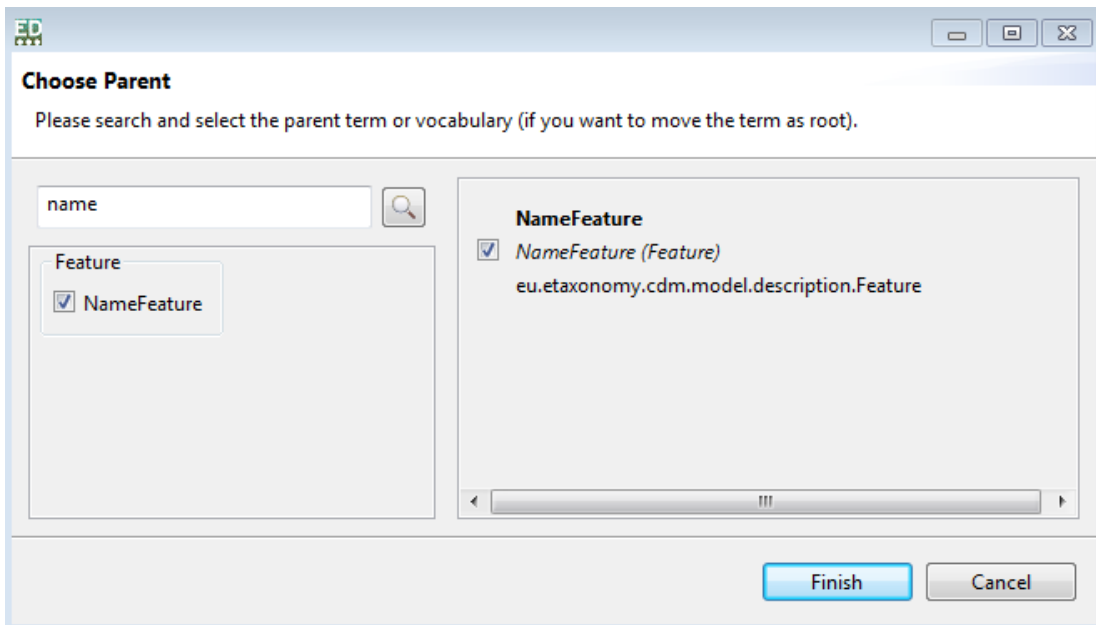
