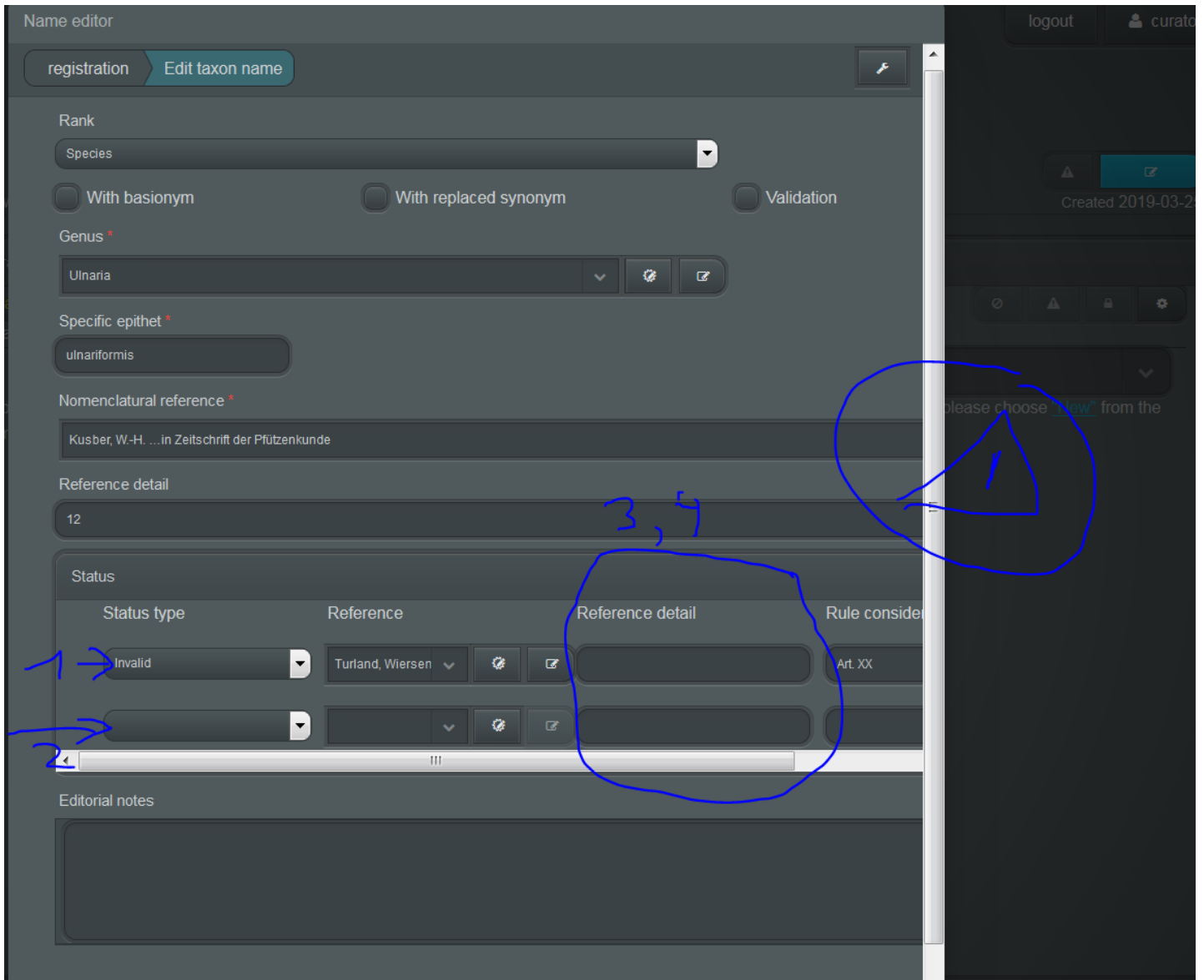

Tested with one and two status, entering and saving without problems, fine.

...but in this form it should not go into production.



Achtung: Nomenclatural reference can not be handled (layout), button not available.

1. List can not be shown to colleagues. For PhycoBank only the terms as shown in the description are needed.
2. We discussed that we only need one Status type (if possible to hinder the new entry in this case)
3. When we put the Reference detail into the description, it was because it is in the CDM. Users do not need this field for page numbers because the code is used mostly in its electronic version. If the Reference detail would be hidden, we had no layout problem, right? [4. Excurs: It would be interesting to link to the respective Article in the ICN, but I guess the Reference detail is the wrong type of field, because a URL field would be necessary. This is a discussion point with low priority]
