Description			
<p>It looks like currently the preferences are deleted no matter what the allowOverride value is. But if it is "false" simply deleting does not seem to be correct as this will force the user to use the default and not a local preference. Question is what do we use as value then. "Null"?</p> <p>Or is there a reason for always deleting the preference if use default is chosen? Maybe alternatively we may disallow allowOverride=false for default values. If we decide so we need to check that default values that come from a more general subject and have a clearly defined value there can not be overridden locally.</p>

because we decided that we want to delete the preference when the user chooses the default value and then it is not possible to define whether allowOverride is set to true or false.

If we want to have the possibility to define "choose default" but do not allow override then we have to save the preference again and think about an entry for the default value.

I can't remember that we decided to delete if "default" was selected AND allowOverride=false. We decided only that if the complete record has a default value it should be deleted. And the complete record has default if value=default AND allowOverride=true (the latter being the default for allowOverride).
