I don't think this is related to **protected** title caches.

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Even if I was pretty sure I did all the tests again. Even with magic wildcard characters it was not possible to get any results in the "Specimen editor (list)". I tried the following patterns: 'OK-1 1788*', 'OK-1 1788%', 'OK-1 1788?'.

So I pass this issue to Patrick.

Your suggestion raises another question: "Why is the behavior of two apparently similar search functions, so much different?" I consider this a usability problem. Either the search functions are behaving the same in the different parts of an application or this must be made clear. Do we have a master ticket for UX problems? I would like to file this issue somewhere.

But also have in minde, that Specimen (Tree) Editor is something very different to the Specimen (list) editor even if it looks similar. No time to search UX ticket, but I think there is something.
