<p>According to ICNAFP (<a href="https://www.iapt-taxon.org/nomen/pages/main/art_3.html">https://www.iapt-taxon.org/nomen/pages/main/art_3.html</a>) phylum and division are the same. Also in the ERMS original database they are handled more or less the same for Plantae.</p> <p>In Rank.csv we have first Phylum with all Super-, Sub-, Infra- etc. ranks and then the same for division. This might be wrong especially related to sort order.</p> <p>Need to check if these ranks are really the same and how they are handled in ICZN and other codes. Maybe they do not exist there.</p>
