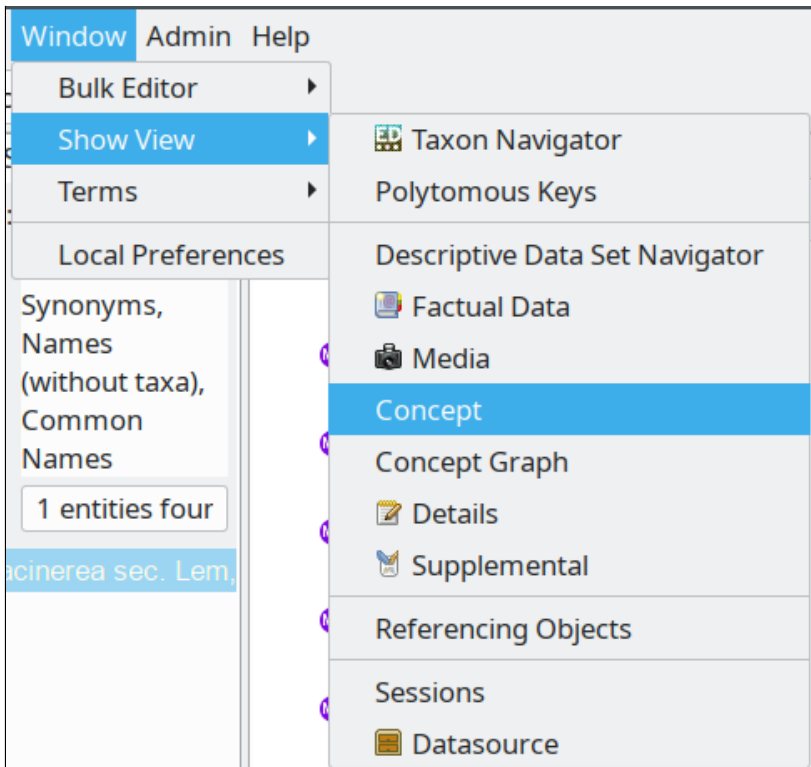
Description

It is hard to find the editor for taxon relationships. The UI gives not hints.

I was searching the UI for a couple of minutes until I noticed the menu entry:



I suggest changing the label of the menu entries to "*taxon concept relationship*" or to "*concept relationship*" since the term "Concept" is semantically too broad.
