Note: this differs from CDM light export where we always have to select a classification and therefore the Finish button is not enabled otherwise. However, also there in this case there is only 1 option and therfore it should be automatically selected - but we may discuss if the classification dropdown should be empty instead of preselected if >1 classifications exist.

By the way: currently when not called from a taxon node the option "Export selected subtree(s)" is not visible. I think it is better to only disable it to make clear that in general this possibility exists (not sure if this differs from former requirements but with some time distance I feel this might be the better solution)
