<p>Currently when entering e.g. "2,3" and pressing OK, the data is not stored but also no warning is given that it is possible to store. Same with values like "abcd".</p> <p>It should be either not possible to enter such data at all (pattern matching) or a warning should show up that it is not a valid value (similar to URI, DOI etc checking)</p>
